This year has been one of growth, achievement, and innovation for our school. As we reflect on the academic year, we celebrate the accomplishments of our students, staff, and community. Our commitment to excellence in education remains unwavering, and we have made significant strides in academics, extracurriculars, and infrastructure development.

***Celebrating Academic Excellence***

1. On 13 th May, SSE and SSCE results were published.
2. In SSCE, 124 Students appeared for the examination. Out of 124, 17 students secured full A1, 42 students secured above 90% and 115 students secured above 75%.
3. The school toppers from each stream were:
  - Eswar S Gopal scored 97% in PCMB.
  - Aadil Varsh scored 98% in PCMCS.
  - V Nandhana secured 98.2% in Commerce.
  - Anagha R R scored 87.2% in Humanities.
4. In SSE, 139 students appeared for the examination, 17 students secured full A1 for all subjects, 39 students secured above 90% and 96 students secured above 75%.
5. The school toppers were R J Gokul and Adhya K with 494 (98.8%).
6. Our school and students were felicitated by Ahalia institution “Vijayotsav” . Our students who secured full A1 and above 90% from 10th and 12th grade received trophies and certificates from the honorable MLA Prabhakaran.

***A Year of Vibrant Endeavors:***

***Infrastructural Development***

The recent infrastructural developments was undertaken to improve facilities for students and staff. These enhanced accessibility, hygiene, and overall learning conditions.

1. Construction of CWSN Toilets

To promote hygiene and sanitation, new toilets were built under the Child-Friendly WASH in Schools (CWSN) initiative. These facilities are designed to ensure clean and accessible sanitation for students, with a focus on maintaining proper hygiene standards.

2. Establishment of a Composite Laboratory

A composite lab has been set up to facilitate science education. This lab accommodates experiments in physics, chemistry, and biology, making it a multifunctional space for students to engage in hands-on learning and practical applications of scientific concepts.

3. Installation of a Lift for Students

To improve accessibility within the building, a student lift has been installed. This is particularly beneficial for students with mobility challenges, ensuring that all learners can move between floors conveniently and safely.

#### 4. Construction of New Washrooms

Additional washrooms have been constructed to meet the growing needs of students and staff.
